

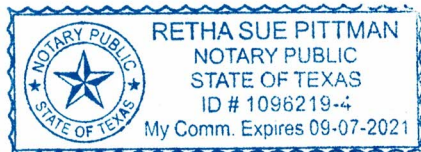


- 1. Items marked with an * are on the consent agenda and will be voted on in one motion unless a Council member asks for separate discussion.
