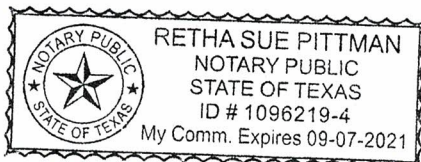


1. Items marked with an \* are on the consent agenda and will be voted on in one motion unless a Council member asks for separate discussion.
